The MCPA Conference Scholarship is your opportunity to apply for funding to attend the annual MCPA conference October 4th-5th, at the Country Inn & Suites in Mankato, Minnesota. To apply for funding, complete the application below.

The MCPA Conference Scholarship is available to crime prevention practitioners that are a 2020 MCPA member and are unable to attend the annual conference due to financial constraints. Members that have not received the MCPA Conference Scholarship since 2016 are eligible to apply.

Awards are based on financial need and are awarded to cover the full conference registration fee, including one night lodging during the conference at the conference hotel. Scholarships do not fund travel and meal costs; however some meals are provided as part of the conference fee. **A limited number of scholarships are available.**
